

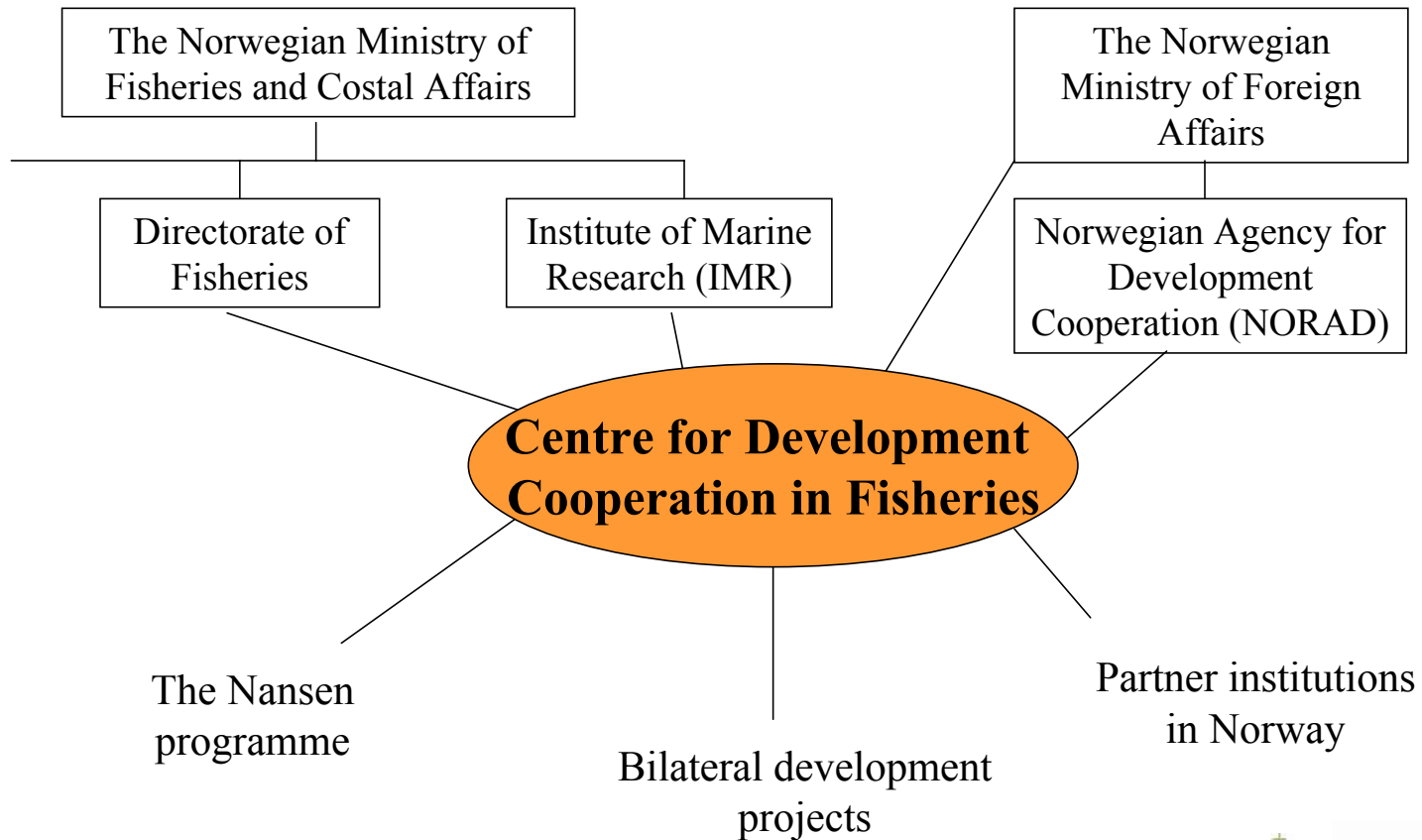

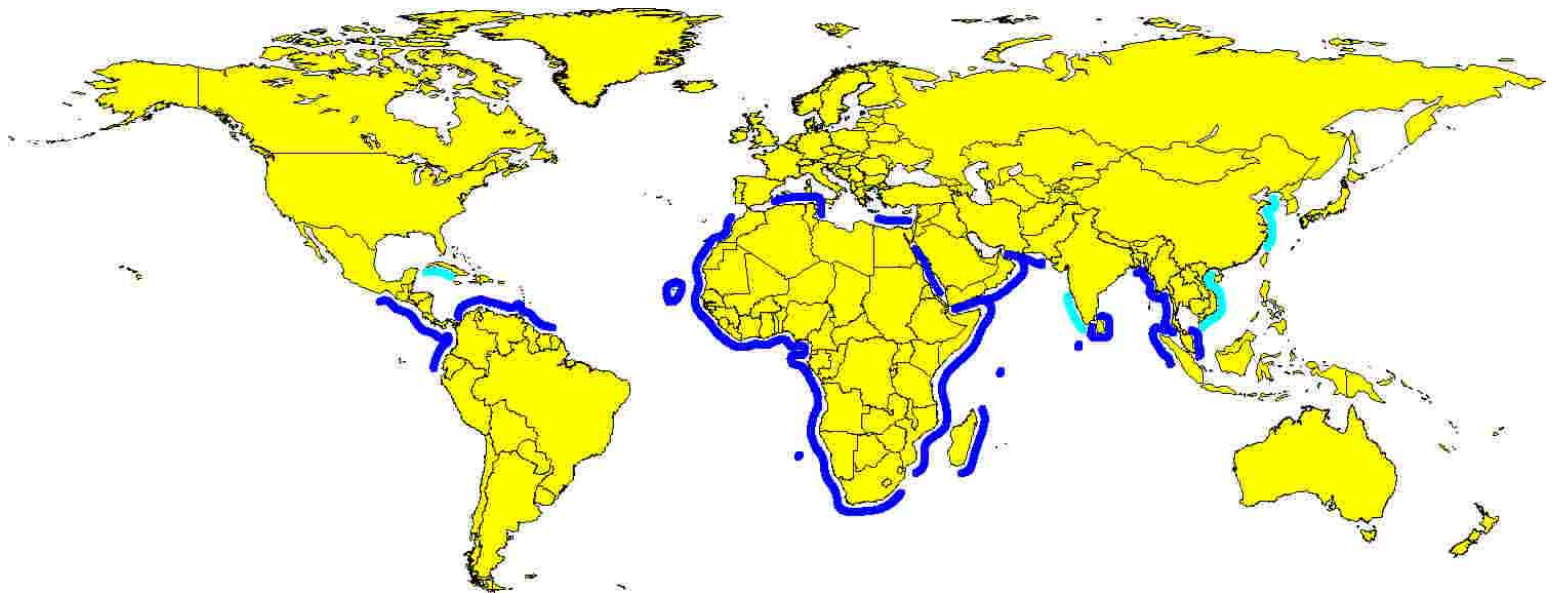

During 2005 the Nansen Programme covers the entire West African coast

- Biomass estimation and mapping of the living marine resources
- Monitoring of the marine environment
- Fish stock assessment as input to management
- Training and capacity building



Decisions by the Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs

- Internationalize the Nansen Programme by 2006
- Provide basic funding from Norway
- Maintain Norwegian ownership and management of the “Dr Fridtjof Nansen”
- Overall Programme responsibility taken over by FAO
- Seek partnership and financing from other donors and interested parties
- Supporting the concept:
 - ”Implementing ecosystem approaches to fisheries management in developing countries”
